

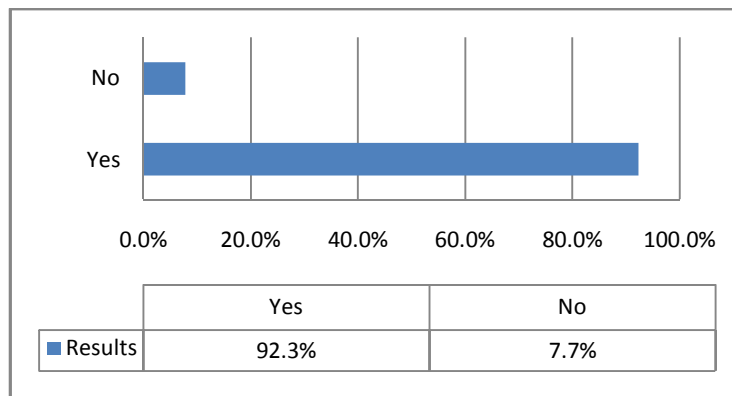

March 21, 2009 to March 27, 2009

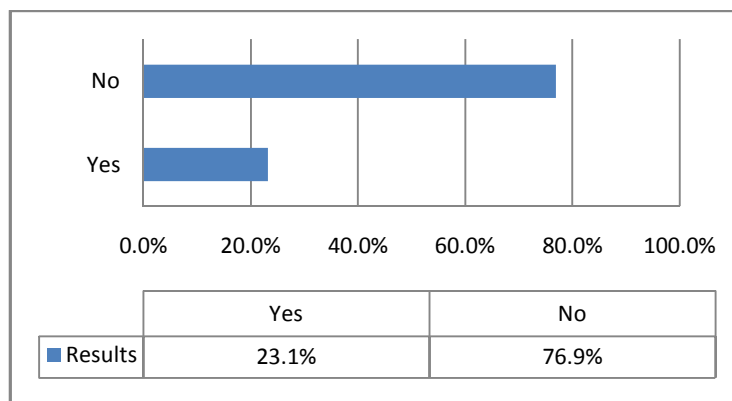

2. Should income taxes be used to encourage corporate productivity?

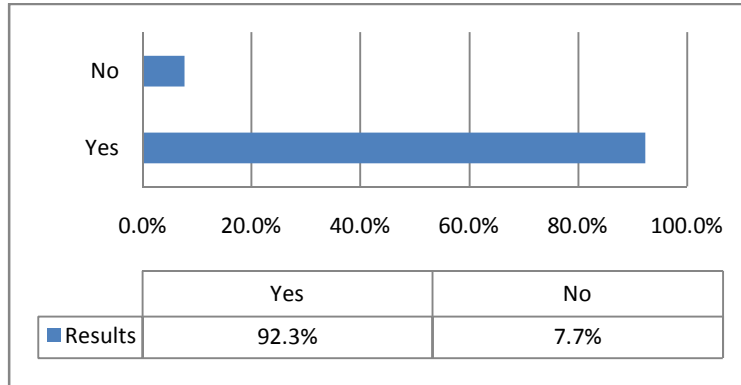

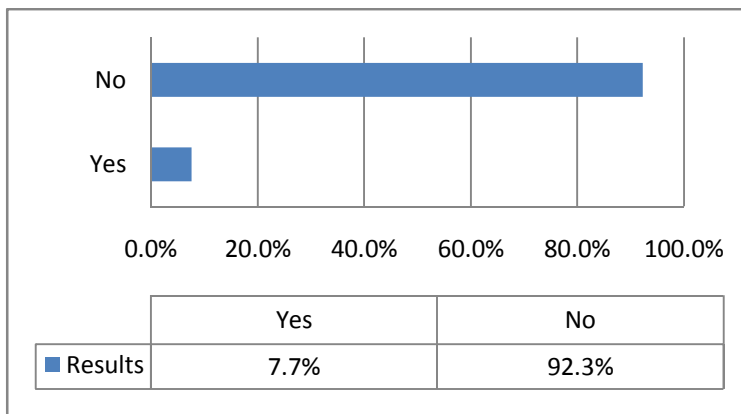
